



Vice President's Report: Steve Brehm reported that he sent out 6 hard copies of the last Cruz News.

<u>Treasurer's report</u>: Mark Peterson submitted a bill for \$319.98 from GoDaddy. It's for an important security piece to our web site. Steve Brehm had new income of \$20.00 from the sale of a tee shirt.

<u>Membership Chairperson</u>: Jim Neher reported that club membership is 85 (146 total). New member, Gil Acevedo, was introduced. Jim had up to date Club rosters. Membership renewals will be sent out the 1st week of November.

<u>Activities:</u> Ron Willson reported that there are no planned shows for the remainder of the year. There were 7 mini shows, in all, this year.

<u>Events</u>: Karen Keenan reported that Ladies' Night Out is scheduled for Thursday, November 3, at 4:00 p.m., at the Apple Valley American Legion.


